Make - Up Shopping List Suggestions

- 1) Foundation - Liquid or powder to match skin tone
Loreal color match powder is easy and inexpensive, Longs
- 2) Eyebrow pencil - Light brown for blondes, brown for brunettes
Wet and Wild
- 3) Eyeshadow only for teens: soft brown or gold tones
- 4) Eyeliner only for teens: gel waterproof liner or pencil
- 5) Mascara-waterproof black Cover Girl in pink and green
- 6) Blush- Bright coral for fair skin Rosy color for darker
- 7) Lipstick - Bright red or pink matte or long wearing Revlon/Longs
- 8) Wet wipes to remove makeup
- 9) Q-tips for mistakes
- 10) Tissues
- 11) Sponges

MAKE-UP APPLICATION

- 1) Apply powder foundation with a sponge or large powder brush. Be sure the face is evenly covered and dry.
- 2) Evenly draw color through the brow, lightly with a pencil or gradually with a brush.
- 3) Apply shadow to the lid with a soft brush completely covering the lid.
- 4) Eyeliner is applied along the upper lash line to emphasize eyes.
- 5) Brush mascara from lash bed to tips.
- 6) Ask your child to smile and apply blush with a big soft brush in rosy circles.
- 7) Apply lipstick directly or with a brush. Blot with a tissue, reapply and blot again for long wear.
